# 2009–10 CUPA Faculty Salary Comparisons for KSU

## Highlights of Faculty Salary Comparisons in Table 1

- KSU's average faculty salaries for the university as a whole and its colleges often tended to be **Below Average** when compared to the average faculty salaries at other public research and doctoral institutions across the nation.
- Below Average salaries for full professors were especially pronounced in the
  College of Humanities & Social Sciences (24% below the average of the comparator
  group) and the Science & Mathematics group excluding the CSIS faculty (26%
  below the average of the comparator group). In other colleges where doctoral
  programs are underway, KSU average salaries for full professors were 11% below
  those in the comparator group in Health & Human Services, 10% below in
  Education, and 13% below in Business.
- At the junior ranks of assistant professor and instructor, KSU's average faculty salaries were often **Comparable** to the averages for other universities, probably because KSU has to be competitive with market conditions when hiring new junior faculty.
- Signs of salary compression in the junior rank of assistant professor exist at KSU
  and nationally in that the average salary for new hires at that rank equal or exceed
  the average salary of continuing assistant professors. In the business fields,
  compression at KSU and nationally is especially prominent in that the average
  salaries of new assistant professors are substantially higher than the average
  salaries of continuing assistant professors.
- Salary compression at the senior rank of full professor is more prominent at KSU
  than at other public universities nationwide in that the expected rise in average
  salary from the associate to full professor is typically substantially smaller here than
  elsewhere. That compression is reflected in the fact that KSU's average salary for
  full professors is 18% below the average of national comparators, whereas KSU's
  averages for associate and assistant professors are only 7% or 9% below the
  national averages.
- Average salaries were highest in the business and computing fields and lowest in the arts, humanities, and social sciences at KSU and at public research universities nationally. The average faculty salary for new assistant professors in the business fields was twice the size of the average for new assistant professors in the arts.
- KSU's Comparable and Above Average salaries in most ranks in Computer & Information Systems probably continue to reflect the influence of Georgia's

Yamacraw special funding initiative earlier in the decade when a number of CS/IS faculty were funded and hired at levels comparable to distinguished professors at research universities.

 KSU's average salaries by rank are typically not representative of any college at KSU. Statistically, the substantially higher salaries in business and computing pull the lower averages in all other disciplines up for the institution as a whole. Consequently, KSU's average salaries in business and computing tend to be higher than the institutional averages at each rank and the averages in all other disciplines tend to be below the institutional averages. That was the case in the national comparator group as well.

About the CUPA Salary Survey. KSU participates annually in the National Faculty Salary Survey conducted by the College and University Professional Association for Human Resources (CUPA). The CUPA survey produces average salary comparisons by federal CIP (Classification of Instructional Programs) codes and permits the customized formulation of comparison groups. Average (mean) nine-month salaries are reported for KSU. The averages reported for comparator groups are the means of the institutional averages. Key results from the CUPA survey were extracted, summarized, and interpreted by the staff of Enterprise Information Management. Doctoral Research University Comparison Group. The "Public Research and Doctoral Institutions" comparison group referenced in this report is CUPA's selection of 330 participating public universities that offer doctoral programs. KSU was included in that group. Listings of the participating universities in the comparison groups are provided in the appendix of this report. It is important to note that this group includes not only KSU's peers in the Doctoral Research University Carnegie category, but also aspirational peers in the High Research Activity Research University and Very High Research Activity Research University categories. Consequently, the national averages for the comparator group actually represent aspirational more than peer faculty salaries. Nevertheless, KSU increasingly competes with aspirational peer universities nationwide in faculty recruitment and must be attentive to national average salaries in order to be competitive. At the junior ranks, KSU typically appears competitive.

**KSU's Position Among Comparators.** To simplify interpretation of the comparisons of arithmetic means, the positions of KSU's averages relative to those of its comparators was coded as **Comparable** to the comparator's average if KSU's average was less than 5 percentage points different, plus or minus. **Below Average** was used if KSU's average was 5 or more percentage points lower than the comparators' average. **Above Average** was used when KSU's average was 5 or more percentage points higher than the comparator's average.

Warnings About Comparing Discipline Averages Based on CIP Codes. The federal Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) codes were designed to classify instructional programs and do not align well or tightly with the classification of faculty members, especially when faculty have advanced degrees from more than one CIP discipline. In addition, inconsistencies in how participating institutions organize their faculties and assign them CIP codes often preclude meaningful departmental or disciplinary comparisons at the

4-digit CIP coding level in the CUPA salary survey results. A summary of the CUPA survey results at the 4-digit level is included in the appendix of this report. KSU's assignments of CIP codes to faculty in different departments have tended to follow the most popular choices of peer institutions participating in the CUPA survey, enabling peer comparisons.

Warnings About Interpreting Averages Derived from a Small Number of Cases Averages (means) calculated on less than 10 cases are typically not reported by CUPA or statisticians in general. Averages calculated on small samples are potentially unstable and unrepresentative because of possible distortion caused by outliers or exceptional circumstances. Consequently, caution is advised when attempting to put much stock in a departmental average at a particular rank that is based only on a few individuals. KSU's college-level averages are more stable since they typically reflect many more than 10 cases.

**KSU College Summaries.** The summaries presented in Table 1 collapsed the CIP codes to the 2-digit level and clustered different disciplinary groups according to KSU's organizational structure of college makeup. The College of Science & Mathematics was divided into two CIP groupings, separating Computer & Information Systems faculty from all others, because salary levels between those groups were so great at KSU and at comparator universities. The College of Education & PTEU includes education faculty members in other colleges beyond Bagwell.
